2021-2022 School Goals

Amana Academy set goals for the 2021-2022 school year: 100% of Amana students will meet their iReady typical growth goal by May 31, 2022, and 80% of students scoring no less than one grade level below on the fall iReady diagnostic will reach their iReady stretch growth goal by May 31, 2022.

Communication at Amana Academy means "Communicating Effectively"

Amana Academy will take the following measures to promote and support parents as an important foundation of the school in order to strengthen the school and reach our school goals. We will --

- Ensure that all information related to school and parent programs, meetings, and other activities is published in English, Spanish, and Arabic posted to the school website, and included in school newsletters for all parents in a timely manner.
- Conduct staff development on parent and family engagement practices and Infinite Campus management —trainings will be on the value of parent contributions, how to communicate with and work with parents as equal partners, implementing parent programs, providing information in a format/language understandable to parents, and responding to parent requests for family engagement activities.
- Provide explanations of the curriculum used at school, academic assessment results, workshops on Milestones, Title I, EL model, FastBridge, and other academic trainings to help parents better work with their children to improve achievement
- Share information in English and Spanish on the school website and newsletters for parents to understand the school's academic standards and assessments as well as the ways parents can monitor their child's progress and work with educators.
- Communicate with all families and the community on a regular basis regarding schoolwide events and activities using methods such as weekly newsletters and social media.
- Provide necessary materials to parents at conferences, meetings, and activities to help parents work with their child to improve their child's academic achievement.
- Offer parent classes to help further enhance the various education backgrounds including workshops on boosting student's math and reading skills and using technology including education about the harms of copyright piracy.
- Provide multiple and flexible meetings throughout the year at convenient times for parents to support the partnership between home, school, and community to improve student academic success.
- The residential facilities for students in the Amana Academy attendance area are included in the family engagement correspondence and activities.
- Offer Before-School and After-School childcare for families, along with providing families transportation services as needed through our Front Office.

School – Family Compact

As part of this plan, Amana Academy and our families have developed a School-Family-Student Compact, which is an agreement that families, teachers, and students will de-velop that explains how our families and teachers will work together to make sure all students reach grade-level standards. The Family-Compacts are reviewed and updated annually based on feedback from parents, students, and teachers during the Parent Feedback Meeting. The School-Family-Student compacts are distributed to parents dur-ing the beginning of each school year in order to review throughout the year and will be posted online in our website prior to Nov 1, 2021.

Title I Budget—Reservation of Parent and Family Engagement Funds by "Sharing Power"

Parents share in decision-making regarding how our Title I Funds are allocated. Title I stipulates that 1% of funds are set-aside to be budgeted for parent and family engagement resources and activities. Parent input determines how the 1% budget is spent, for example, academic resources, educational materials, etc. Budget input from parents is collected in the Spring. Budget input for the 2022-2023 school year, will be collected in Spring 2022.

Coordination of Services

Amana Academy coordinates and integrates family engagement programs, activities and strategies to help parents more fully participate in the education of their child. Our activities integrate strategies to provide resources for parents to help their child achieve College and Career Readiness. To seamlessly integrate pre-K families into the Kinder-garten program, Amana will host tours and open-house days for families in Spring 2022, and offer resources to ensure that families are supported and fully participating.
