Policy Detail

At Amana Academy, we recognize that there is a strong, positive correlation between appropriate attire, good work habits and good character. Amana Academy believes that a dress code and/or a policy of wearing uniforms will benefit student learning in the following ways:

- When dress and appearance are characterized by cleanliness, neatness, modesty and safety, students generally have a more positive attitude toward themselves and those around them.
- When students look well groomed and with a uniform-look, this gives an outward sign of being a community.
- Uniforms also lessen peer pressure and enhance self-esteem.
- They promote a focus on the development of the "inside" of the students rather than the externals and what the students are wearing.
- Wearing uniforms shows equality of all students by de-emphasizing economic differences.
- Uniforms are practical, durable, and economical.

The dress code details will be published in the Family Handbook and on the Amana website prior to the first day of each school year, and it will be the responsibility of parents and students to ensure compliance with this code. Every effort will be made to accommodate special needs, meaning the school will assist parents who cannot afford the uniform; or another example being that the school will allow deviations from the uniform for personal health or religious reasons and other appropriate reasons.

All students are expected to dress according to the school's student dress requirement (listed below). Each student is required to own a uniform in good, clean condition and is expected to wear it at all times except on designated "Out of Uniform" days.

Discipline/enforcement measures will be implemented by the administration to ensure the Amana uniform policy is being followed. Any questions that parents may have concerning the appropriate dress of a student may be discussed with the teacher or administrator. When specific clarification is necessary, the Director will make the final determination.

Out-of-Uniform Guidelines:

Out-of-uniform days are allowed on specific days during the academic year. On out-of-uniform days students are expected to be dressed appropriately and modestly.

- 1 Clothing must be clean and pants should be free of rips and tears.
- 2 Skirts and/or shorts must be worn no shorter than the top of knee.
- 3 Students are not allowed to wear tank tops, spaghetti strap tops, strapless tops, halter tops, mesh or see-through tops, beach shoes, flip-flops, backless shoes, sports sandals, short shorts, t-shirts/shirts which display advertisements for alcohol, cigarettes, or that uses inappropriate language.
- 4 The students' shoes on an out of uniform day must comply with the guidelines

stated in the Amana Family Handbook. The heels of the shoes should not exceed 1 inch.

- 5 If a student has physical education on an out of uniform day, they must have shoes appropriate for the class.
- 6 Students are not allowed to wear hats indoors during the school day.
